Item: **Resolution 2019-25**, Approving An Extension For One Year To The City's Agreement With The Firm Of M. T. Causley To Provide Building Inspection Services In An Amount Not To Exceed \$145,000; Appropriating Funds; and Providing For An Effective Date

BACKGROUND:

The City of Marathon needs building inspection services. The firm of M. T. Causley has continuously provided said services diligently and expeditiously. The City will require further continuous services from M. T. Causley. The City wishes to continue services for one year, with a provision to extend services at the end of that year, and said services not to exceed \$145,000.

FISCAL NOTE:

The FY19 adopted budget for the Building Department includes appropriations of \$72,800 for outsourced building inspection services; however, staff positions for inspectors are budgeted but have not been filled. A budget line item transfer can be approved by the City Manager to reallocate the line items accordingly to cover this contracted expense. Appropriations for FY20 services will have to be included in the next budget cycle.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA APPROVING AN EXTENSION FOR ONE YEAR TO THE CITY'S AGREEMENT WITH THE FIRM OF M. T. CAUSLEY TO PROVIDE BUILDING INSPECTION SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$145,000; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon has need of building inspection services; and

WHEREAS, the firm of M. T. Causley has continuously provided said services diligently and expeditiously; and

WHEREAS, the City will require further continuous services from M. T. Causley approximating \$12,000 per month; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to continue services for one year, with a provision to extend services at the end of that year, and said services not to exceed \$145,000,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Extension of the M. T. Causley Agreement is granted in a not to exceed amount of \$145,000. Said Agreement shall be reviewed one year hence in consideration of additional extensions to the Agreement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
