

REQUEST FOR PUBLIC RECORDS EXEMPTION

F.S. 119.071 4(2). An agency that is the custodian of the information and that is not the employer of the officer, employee, justice, judge, or other person specified in the State Statutes Chapter 119, shall maintain the exempt status of that information only if the officer, employee, justice, judge, other person, or employing agency of the designated employee submits a written request for maintenance of the exemption to the custodial agency.
