RESOLUTION 2019-97**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2019, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (the "FY 2019-2020"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

**WHEREAS**, on September 19, 2019, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2019-2020, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.** The FY 2019-2020 final millage rate for the City of Marathon is 2.59 mills, which is \$2.59 for each thousand dollars of taxable assessed property value; and the tentative millage rate is greater than the rolled-back rate of 2.4459 mills by 5.89%.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
