**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2019-98**

**A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING
THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020; AUTHORIZING
THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY THE BUDGET;
AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2019, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (the “FY 2019-2020”), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2019, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate, and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2019-2020, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the City has set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the final operating budget for FY 2019-2020 in the amount of \$83,763,914.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The FY 2019-2020 final operating budget is adopted.

Section 2. Funds appropriated in the FY 2019-2020 budget may be expended by and with the approval of the City Manager in accordance with the City Charter, State law, and the ordinances, resolutions and policies and procedures of the City. Supplemental appropriations or the reduction of appropriations, if any, shall be made in accordance with the City Charter.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
