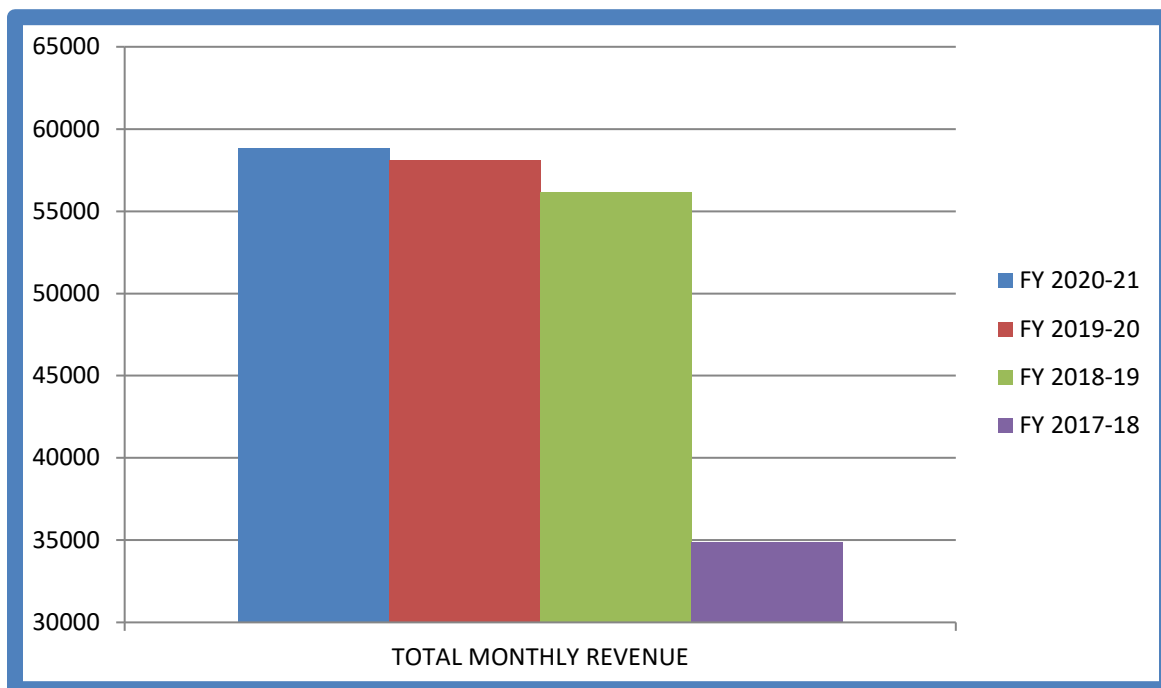

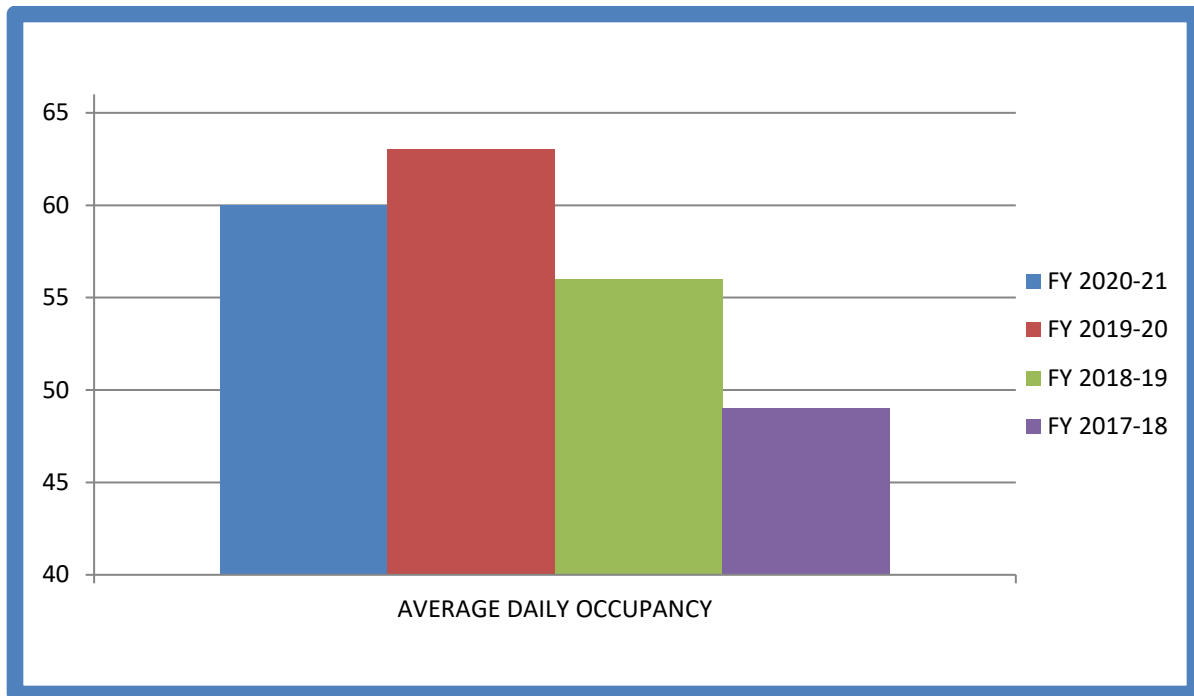
Re: October Monthly Report

Revenue: City Marina saw \$58,865 in total revenue during the month of October.

News: Due to Covid and social distancing rules and regulations, the marina was unable to host all the annual events this year. However, we are still hopeful for next year.

The marina is finally able to rent dock slips to transient or long time residents as it has been closed since Irma. With the marina renting out slips we are hoping to see an increase in revenue.
