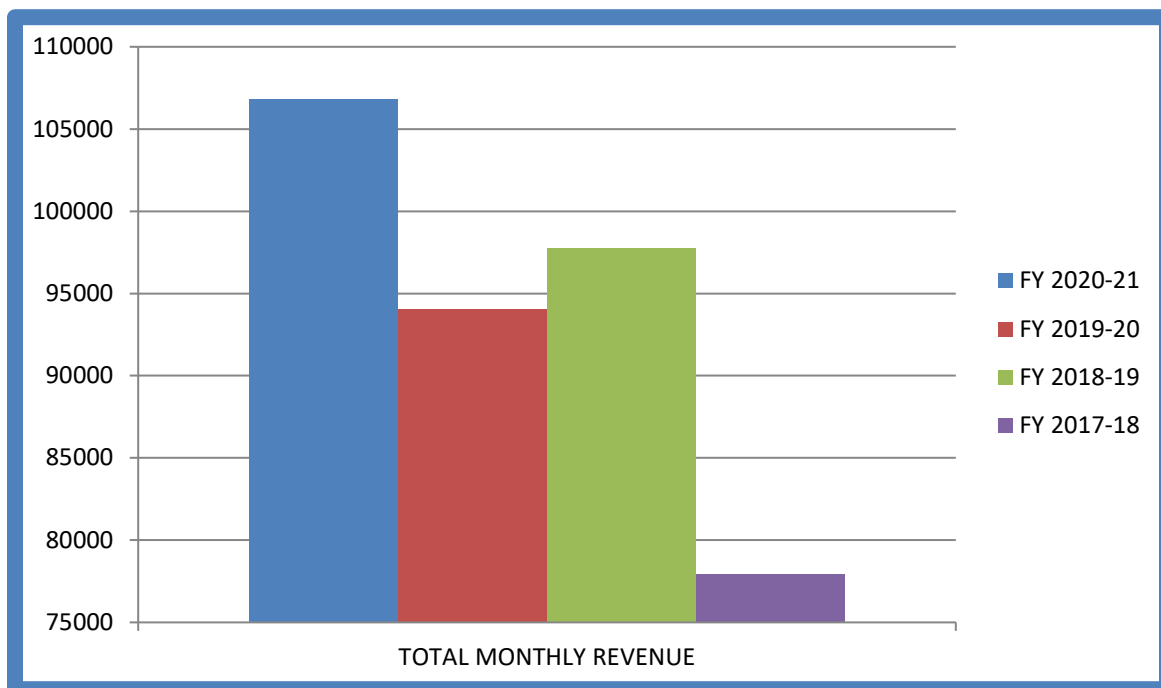

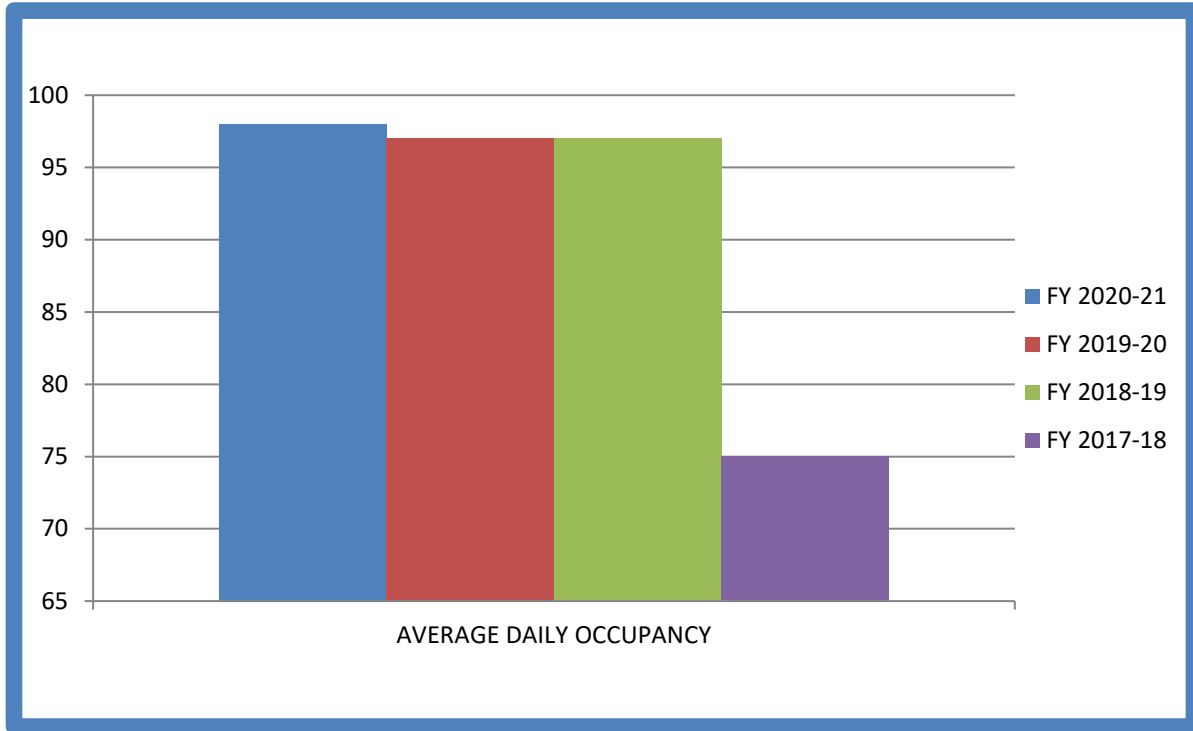
**Re:** December Monthly Report

**News:** The mooring field reached 100% occupancy this month and the marina is now using a waiting list. Our annual Bike Fund was a big success, thanks to our generous donations, as we were able to raise enough funds to purchase 35 new bikes for the children of Marathon. The leasing of our gravel parking lot area to Structural Group Company and FKEC to use to launch (with a crane) sectional barges for their upcoming project commences on Jan. 6<sup>th</sup>. A fee is being assessed for the use of the property.
