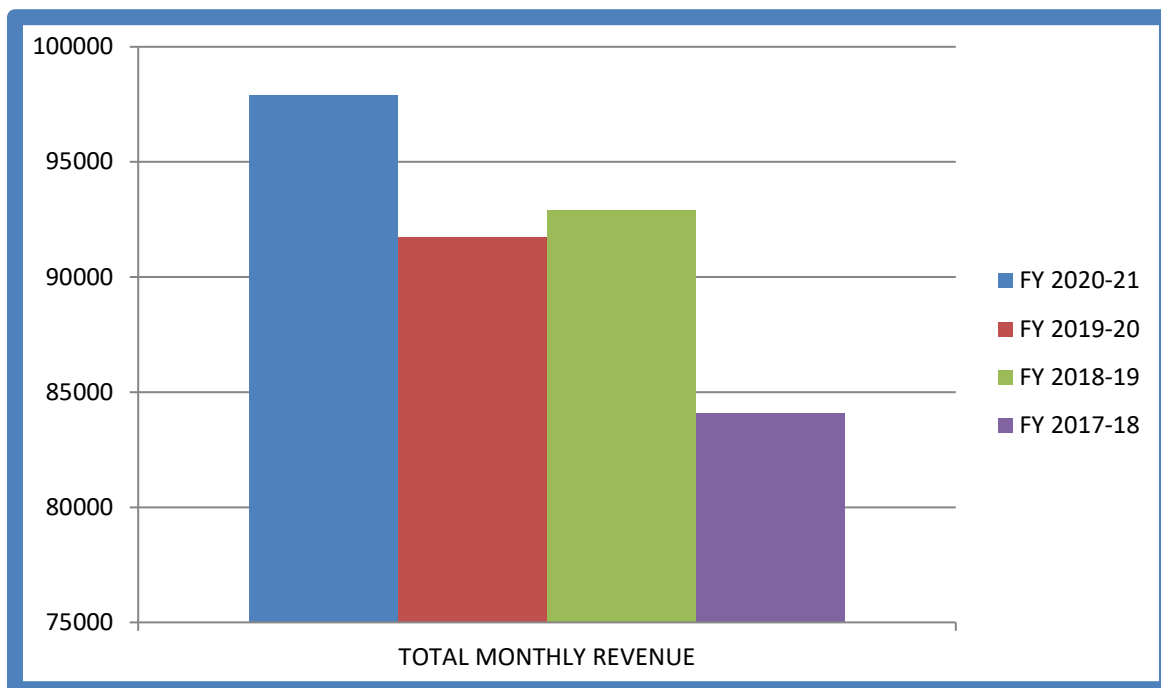

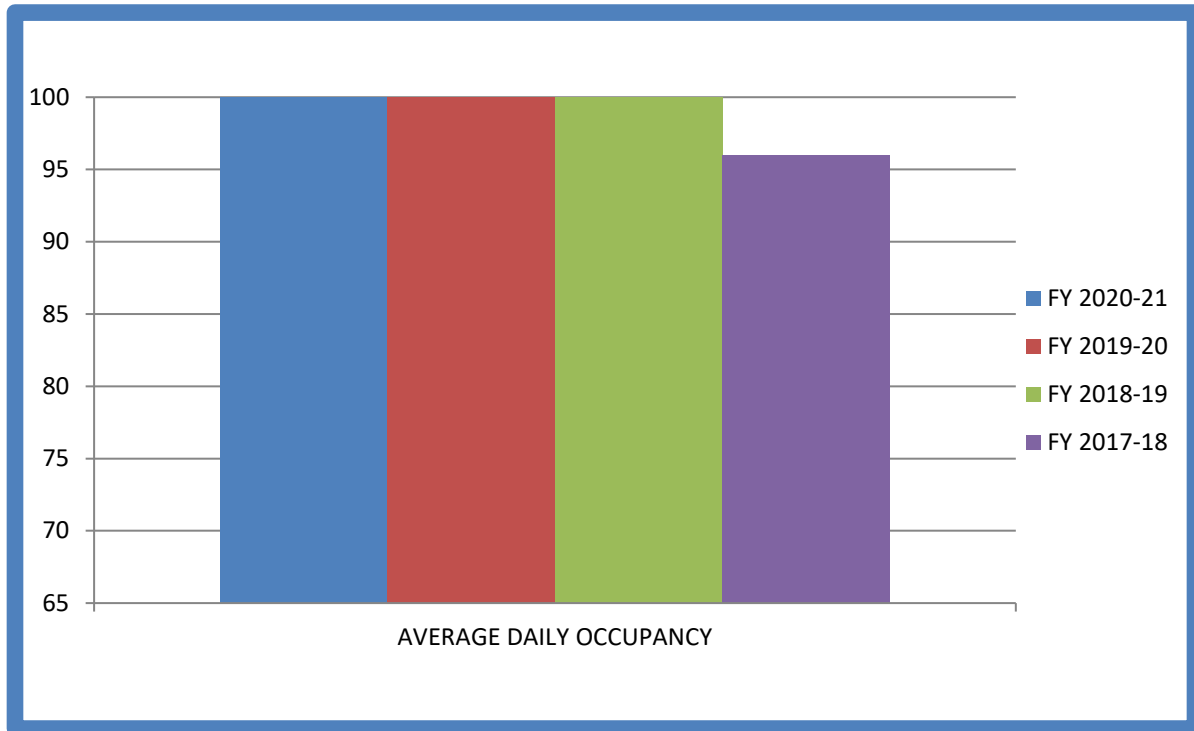
Re: February Monthly Report

Revenue: City Marina saw \$97,890 in total revenue during the month of February.

News: The marina has remained at 100% occupancy with a waiting list the entire month of February and closed the month with 7 vessels on the waiting list. This is an unusually low number especially considering most vessels are not traveling due to COVID.

Projects: The first of the tri-annual cleaning and inspection of our moorings by Seamar Divers is underway. Water quality testing by Flowers Chemical was conducted and passed with flying colors. Marina staff installed a solar powered light to our flagpole to illuminate it at night. Normal repairs were made to the bath house for wear and tears.
