# **CURRENT GRANTS STATUS**

#### CDBG-DR Voluntary Home Buyout Program - DEO

- Subcontractor proposal to be presented to Council at June's meeting for approval.
- June 10th meeting with Project Team to set project schedule and expectations.
- The Environmental Assessment for the project has been drafted.

#### Economic Development Competitive Grant – DEO

- Review of draft of asset inventory in process
- Surveys received concerning feedback on the economic development priorities and challenges.
  - o Public Survey and public feedback results being tabulated.
- Project Team made site visit to Marathon and toured different sites of interest to talk with multiple stakeholders.
  - o Project Team has developed an outline of the economic development strategy and is currently hard at work on the first draft of this plan.
- Met with Project Team to discuss next steps, info to be included/considered for final economic development strategy
- Scheduling 2nd stakeholders meeting. Will be like 1st meeting.

- Awarded bid and notice to proceed for Tourist Impact Study to ADEPT.
- Putting out RFQ's for the construction.

- Data collection completed.
- Review of Adaptation Action Plan in progress
- Preparing Survey/Questionnaire to post on City website calling for comments.

### FKWQIP WWT 3 & 4 – US ACE

• PCA scope amendment is with ACOE then will go to Council for approval.

## Hazard Mitigation Grant Generators – DEM
