The City of Marathon has been using Crypsis Group for incident response monitory software City wide for cybersecurity protection and monitoring of all computers and office 365 email since March of 2020. The software allows 24/7 monitoring and resource allocations to solve any cybersecurity issues. This cybersecurity package is needed for city-wide security and monitoring of computers and email, this will greatly enhance and shield the city from future cyber-attacks. A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA APPROVING CYBER SECURITY SOFTWARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,420 ANNUALLY; AUTHORIZING THE WAIVER OF BIDDING PROCEDURES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the “City”) has been using Crypsis Group for incident response monitory software City wide for cybersecurity protection and monitoring of all computers and office 365 email since March of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the software allows 24/7 monitoring and resource allocations to solve any cybersecurity issues. This cybersecurity package is needed for city-wide security and monitoring of computers and email, this will greatly enhance and shield the City from future cyber-attacks.

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends waiving the bidding process due to the recommendation of this particular software from the City’s insurance carrier; and

WHEREAS, City staff determined the cyber security protection and monitoring software meets the current and future needs of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The invoice in the amount of \$54,420 is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City and bidding procedures are waived.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
