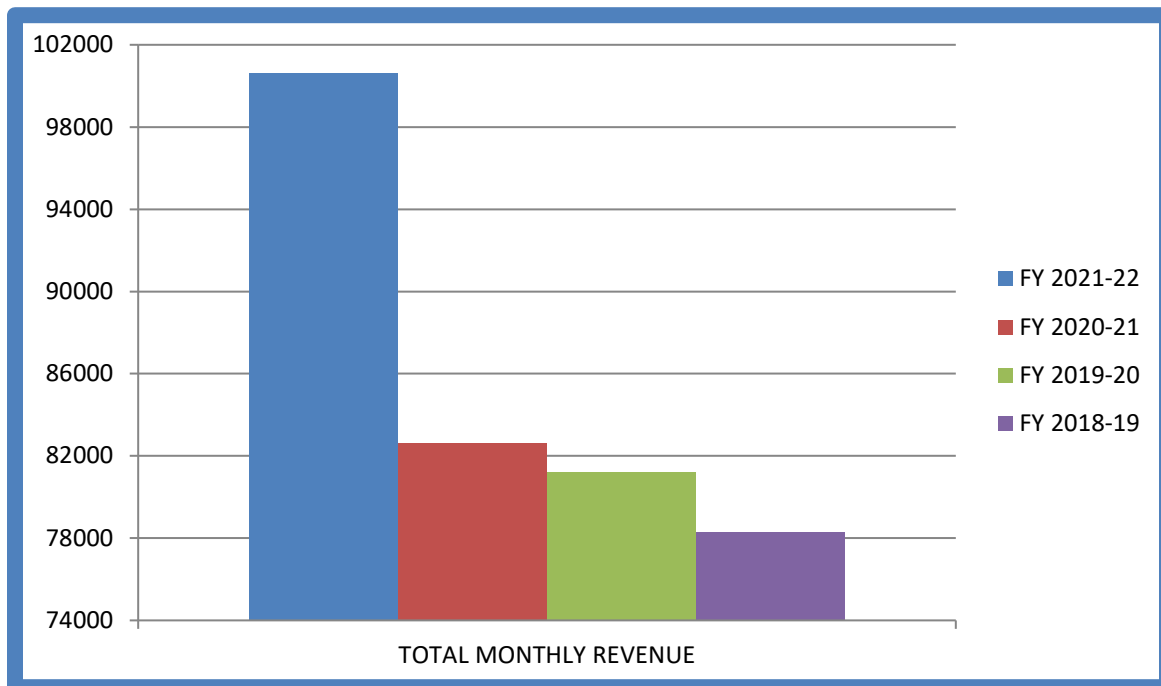

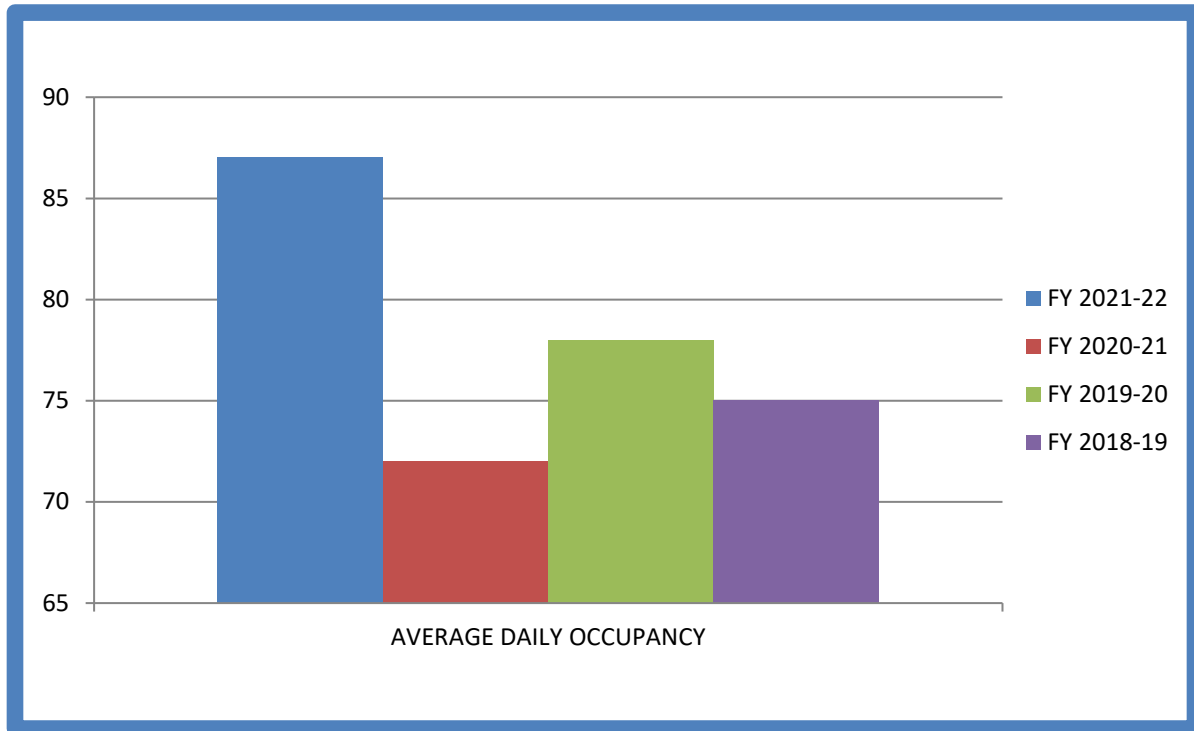
Re: November Monthly Report
