Attached please find this year's application package requesting permission for non-exclusive use of the City's bike path/sidewalk (Bayside) on Saturday, May 21st, for runners making their way towards Key West. This request is identical to that of previous years.

Individual and team runners beginning the 100-mile race in Key Largo will stop briefly at the Marathon Garden Club to record their interim time and meet their support crew or mates, then continue on their way. In addition, individual and team races of 50 miles will begin at the Marathon Garden Club at 9:00am, with staggered starts until roughly 9:30am. These runners will also race along the Bayside bike path/sidewalk until just before Seven Mile Bridge. There, off-duty Sheriff Deputies will cross runners to the Ocean side, where they will continue on the shoulder across the Bridge facing traffic. As always, we will "cone" the shoulder on the bridge. No further City facilities or resources are requested.

Please let me know if any additional information is needed. I will be in attendance at the City Commission meeting on February 8 should there be any questions at that time.
