#### PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT

### **PROGRAMS**

- We started T-ball, baseball, and softball season practices Monday, March 28<sup>th</sup>.

- Baseball and softball games start the week of April 11<sup>th</sup> with opening ceremonies that Monday, April 11<sup>th</sup> here at the Community Park.
- Start-smart baseball began Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> for 6 weeks.

# **Sombrero Beach**

### **Community Park**

- The bocce group has started to dwindle down. The liaison for the group mentioned they would be done with their league Wednesday, April 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - o The goal is to have permanent bocce courts by November or December this year.
- Pickleball numbers have grown, so we've extended the schedule to Monday Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on the basketball courts. On average there's about 20-30 people a day show up to play pickle ball at the Community Park.
- MMHS Tennis season came to an end Friday, April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Community Park playground equipment is schedule to be shipped mid-May. Kristine from Play Worx
  will let us know when she would like to schedule demolition of the old Community Park so they can
  prepare for the installation of the new equipment.
- The amphitheater will be closed until further notice. The shade was removed and stored away. Waiting on the paint crew to come out and do the painting of the metal structure.

# **Rotary Park / Dog Park**

- No issues at Rotary Park as of now.
- Rotary will be hosting a Easter Egg hunt, Saturday, April 16<sup>th</sup> at Rotary Park
- Rotary Park renovations is still scheduled for mid to late June. We will have to determine a
  date and time when the park will need to be closed for tear down in preparation for the
  new playground equipment installation.
- We would like to do a brick fundraiser for the new playground structure. The selling of the bricks would off-set the cost for the playground apparatuses.
- We have been in touch with a company who specializes in brick fundraisers (see attached photos)
  - Bricks would be sold for \$100 (4x4), \$200 (8x8 in)
  - Some of the bricks from the first Rotary build you cannot see some of the writing on the bricks so it's hard to determine who's name is on the bricks. We will also give any of the owners of the bricks from the first build an opportunity to pick up their brick and purchase a new one for the new playground structure if they so desire.
- We are also looking into doing a playground apparatus fundraiser so people/businesses can purchase parts of playground apparatuses and get a plaque with their name on or near the playground apparatus they purchased. This fundraiser will also help off-set the cost of the entire playground structure.
- There was a total of **3** pavilion rental at Rotary Park for the month of March
