Agenda Item: **Resolution 2023-04** Awarding The Contract For Modification The Area 3 Vacuum Main To Reynolds Construction, LLC In An Amount Not To Exceed \$39,890.00; Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into Agreements In Connection Therewith, Appropriating And Expending Budgeted Funds; And Providing For An Effective Date

BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION:

The city continues to expand and the vacuum main that serves 35th, 37th, and Louisa streets is approaching its maximum allowable hydraulic loss. This modification redirects the flows from this area from the Area 4 plant to the Area 3 plant thereby reducing the distance traveled and reducing the hydraulic losses in the line.

Reynolds offers to perform the scope of work for **\$39,890.00**.

Reynolds has assumed the following for this proposal, any deviations may result in a decrease or increase in pricing:

- The attached valve submittal is an acceptable valve for the project.
- All work will be performed via the open cut method with only minor sidewalk repairs required.
- No road closures required and no work under the roadway.
- Minimal traffic control (foot traffic only).
- Owner to supply all required permits if applicable.
- Work shall begin upon material delivery.
- Both lines have wyes for tie in points.
- Schedule 40 PVC (green) piping is compatible with the existing system.
- Solvent welded joints shall be utilized.

Thank you for allowing Reynolds to quote this work for the City of Marathon.
