#### PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT

##### PROGRAMS

- Youth basketball season started with practices starting on Monday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. Games will start on Monday, February 6<sup>th</sup>.
- MYC closed their registration for youth baseball on February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Evaluations starting on Tuesday, February 7<sup>th</sup>.
