PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT

PROGRAMS

- Youth basketball season was cut short a week because of the youth baseball season starting. We
 decided it would be best for parents.

- Pickleball tournament will be held at the Community Park, March 27th 29th starting at 5:00 p.m.
- CMPR and Balanced Paws will be hosting a Behavioral Dog Seminar every Tuesday evening at the Community Park from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. only 10 spots are available.
- The Gardens at Community Park Open House and Plant Giveaway every Wednesday from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the main pavilion
- Chess in the Park every Wednesday from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the Community Park.

EVENTS

BEACHES

Sombrero Beach

- We continue to sanitize and restock the toilet paper in the restrooms in the mornings, afternoons, and evening hours.
 - o Spring break has started so the beach is starting to fill up quickly daily.

- We've had a few visitors requesting the use of our water wheelchair. Currently, we only have one wheelchair, so we are going to purchase another wheelchair incase more than one person is requesting to use the chair.
- The shade structure is still down at the beach. Placed an order for a new shade from Superior. Spoke to a representative on 2/28/23. The shade will be shipped out the week of April 3rd. An installer will be scheduled to come down that week to install the shade and teach our staff how to install the new shade.
- We're looking into replacement for the playground structure and surfacing. Those areas are starting
 to deteriorate faster than normal due to the salt, sand, and sun. The new structure will be like the
 material used at Rotary Park. plus, it will have a coating on the metal parts to help those areas last
 longer in the elements.
- Installed new baby changing stations in the restrooms.
- Installed "dog on a leash" signs at each entrance and along the path at the beach.
