- All is good at Ocean Front Park

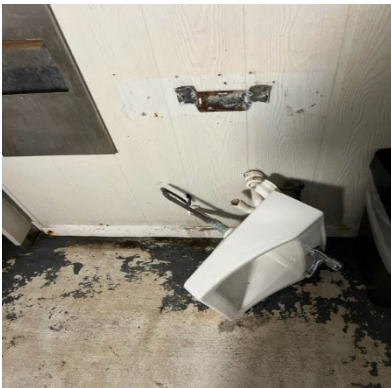
Rotary Park / Dog Park
