July was a very busy and active month. Deputies responded to 5,185 calls for service this month which was slightly higher than last month. Deputies still were able to make 117 arrest and Notice to appear cases and an impressive 14 DUI investigations. The Criminal Investigations Unit, continues to be very active with their case load. All deputies were active in all areas this month.

Marine Deputy Willie Guerra also continues to make resource cases to include possession of lobster out of season and possession of queen conch.

Extra patrols during this hectic time produced an amazing 903 traffic stops this month

Marathon Deputies continue to make an impact in our community with local clean ups and community projects.

Sergeant Joel Slough made a Human Smuggling Case that resulted in 4 arrest.



Crime/Arrest Report:

Detective White- MCSO23OFF005606 Robbery, Papa John's Marathon

Yani Franco Velasquez reported that a coworker and manager Stephanie Delgado snatched her phone out of her hand during an argument. Yani went on to state that Delgado then smashed the phone on the ground before then hiding it so LEO could not recover it. Witness Gloria Moses then confirmed the story to be true. **Stephanie Delgado was arrested for Robbery, Criminal mischief over \$1000 and Tampering with evidence.**

Sergeant Slough- Sgt. Slough continues to be pro-active with joint agency investigations and wrote four arrest warrants related to an active Alien Smuggling Organization operating in the Marathon AOR. Sgt. Slough was successful in obtaining two warrants for 23 felony counts of alien smuggling and two warrants for 23 felony counts of conspiracy to commit alien smuggling. Two of the warrants have been served.
