The City's utility rate consultant has recommended that the City pay off the WW637090 loan, and has included this scenario in the 2023 Financial Wastewater and Stormwater Financial Forecast and Analysis. The early payoff of the SRF loan will save the City approximately \$436,403.56 in interest expense and will reduce the annual debt service requirements on the Utilities Fund by \$659,548.52. **CONSISTENCY CHECKLIST:** Yes No 1.
