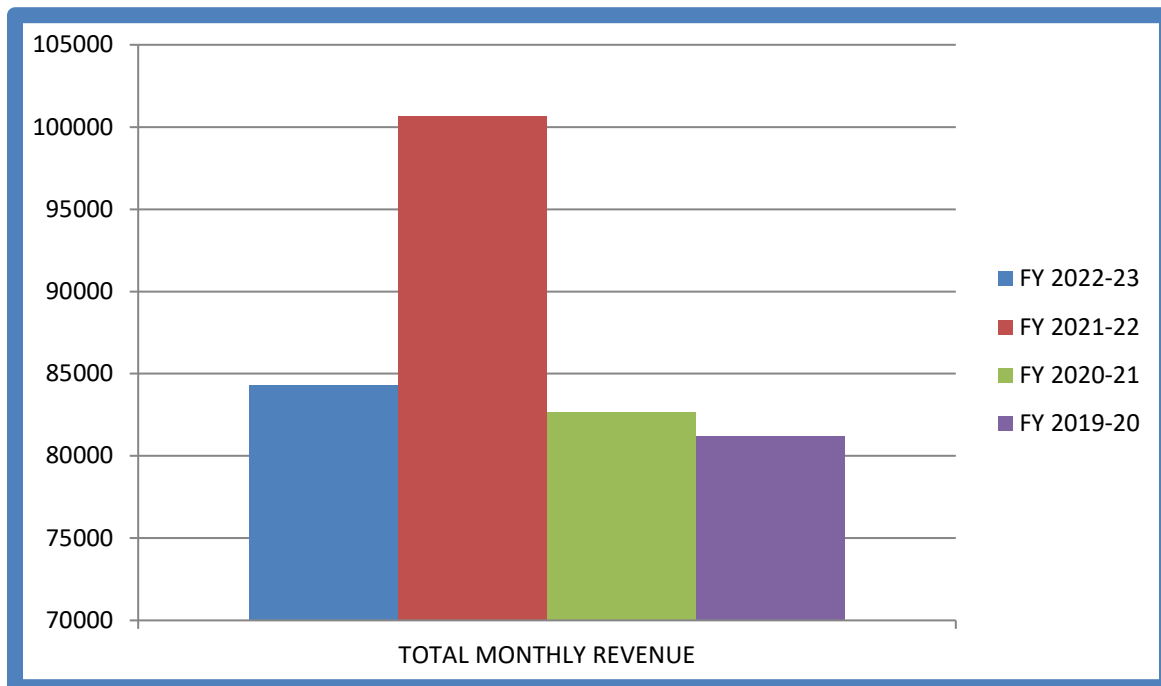

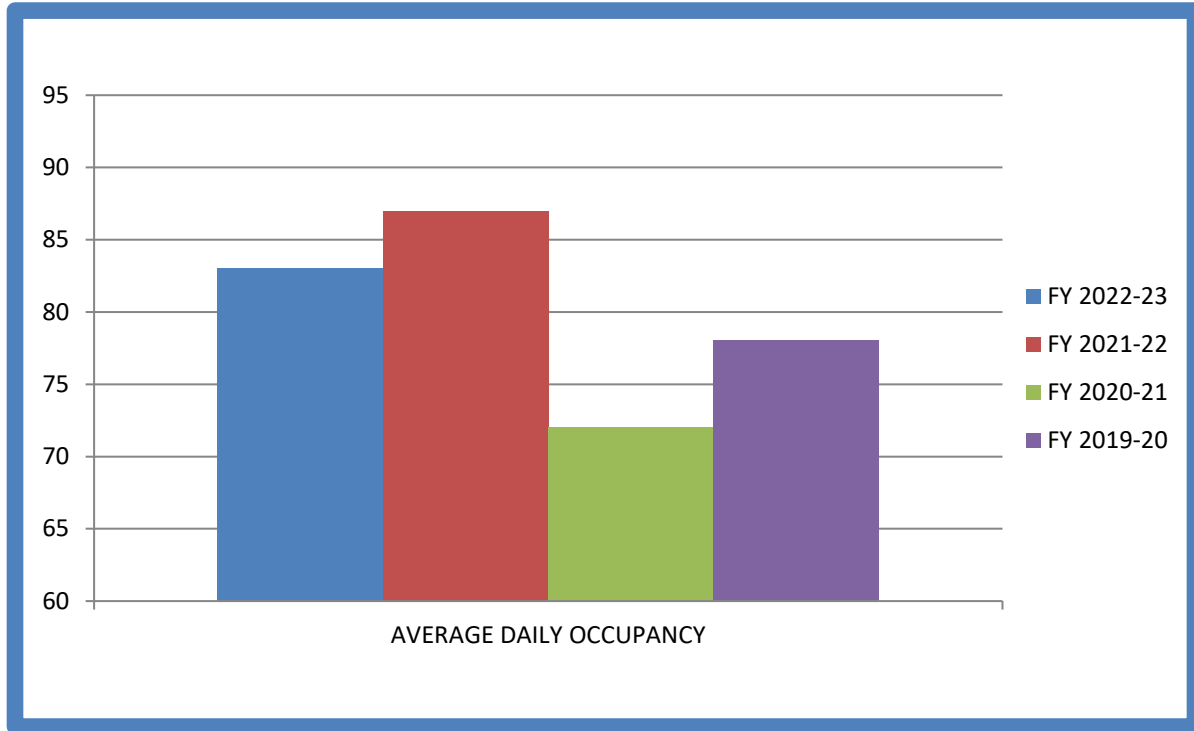
**Re:** November Monthly Report
