Dear Council:

Deputies have an estimated total of 1,035 calls for service, conducted 913 traffic stops and made 58 arrests.

Marine Deputy Willie Guerra only worked a total of 5 days in February due to an injury.

An estimated 614 watch cards were distributed as a result of neighborhood patrols, watch order and extra patrols.

The Criminal Investigations Unit obtained 6 arrest warrants and 5 search warrants. Collectively detectives had 10 arrests.

MCSO23OFF009339: Forged Checks

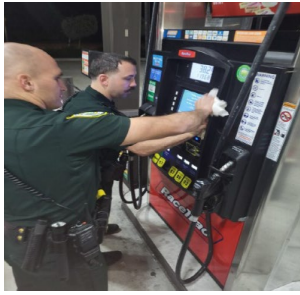
