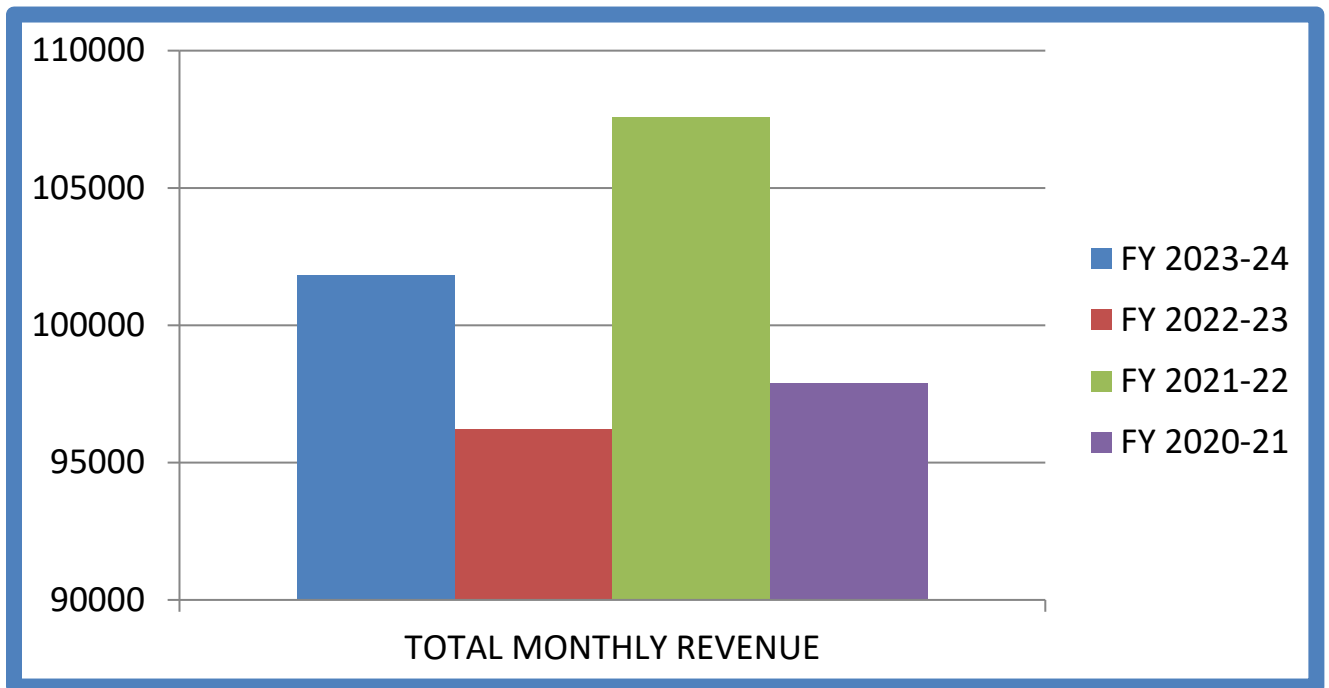

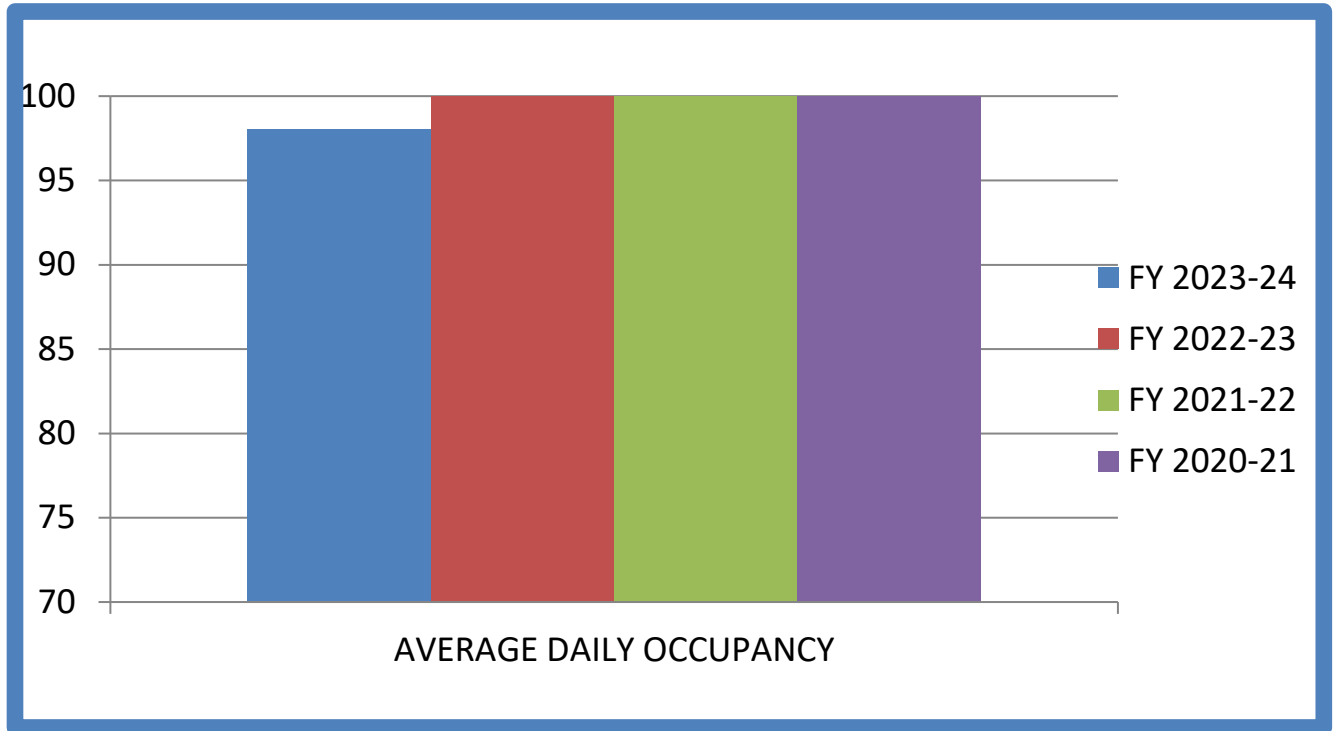
**Re:** February Monthly Report

Revenue: City Marina saw \$101,809 in total revenue for the month of February.





Occupancy: February's average daily occupancy was 98%.
