A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CHANGE TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AND SYNAGRO, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City"), and Synagro (the "Contractor") entered into an Contract on June 11, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, on June18, 2025 the City received a letter from the Contractors stating the increase in dry ton price adjustment effective July 13, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Such price(s) shall be adjusted based on the Annual Percentage Increase of Non-Seasonally Adjusted Consumer Price Index established by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for Water, Sewer and Trash Collection or 2%, whichever is greater, with the base being May 2024. We hereby inform you that an adjustment for cost escalation has been calculated as follows:
