Parks and Recreation Report

PROGRAMS

- Open Pickleball play continues M-F 8am-1pm-About 30-40 people per day our playing
- Youth Basketball finished up with about 70 kids playing games for 6 weeks
- M-W-F Fitness Class is ongoing from 8:30-9:30 in the morning.
- Senior Softball started back up on Tue/Thur/ and Sundays
- Non-City Sponsored Yoga Events Started back
- Home School PE class started back up on Thursdays with an average of 35 kids per week
