Parks and Recreation Report

PROGRAMS

- Open Pickleball play continues M-F 8am-1pm-About 20 people per day are playing

- M-W-F Fitness Class is ongoing from 8:30-9:30 in the morning
- Bocce Ball on Tuesday and Thursday with about 20 people playing each time
- Weekly Parks Program at Kreative Kids Day Care on Wednesdays
- Weekly Wednesday Community Gardens Program and Plant Give-A-Way
- Adult Volleyball and Adult Basketball at the High School
- MYC started youth baseball season ended
- Home School PE ended for the school year
- Summer Camp Registration opened

EVENTS

- There were 2 Turtle Releases with one happening on Earth Day that were well attended
- We held a Volleyball Tournament for the Coast Guard which was a lot of fun with 30 active-duty members signing up to play
- We had 2 Art in the Park Events that were well attended
- We hosted a field day for 1st graders from Stanley Switlik at Community Park

REPAIRS AND IMPROVMENTS

- Skate Park construction is ongoing
- Resodding of the Soccer Field began
- Plans for demoing the Fire Tower are ongoing due to safety concerns in the structure-so we have barricaded the tower and pavilion for safety.
- Windscreens were hung up at the tennis courts.
- 2 leaks were fixed at Community Park near the baseball fields.
- 4 new grills were put in at Sombrero to replace 4 old ones
- Bleachers were repaired at the baseball field
- Ripped Shade sail was replaced at Jesse Hobbs Park
- A park bench was donated to Sombrero Beach from the Colonna-Romano family in honor of their family Member Pietro Colonna-Romano, who was an avid user of the beach and the tennis courts, who suddenly passed away earlier in the year.
