Justice Lee Athletic Achievement Proclamation

WHEREAS, Justice Lee has demonstrated exceptional dedication, discipline, and perseverance throughout her high school athletic career in both Track & Field and Weightlifting; and

WHEREAS, Justice Lee has earned an impressive thirteen (13) total medals at the State Championships across her two sports, including four (4) State Championship gold medals — one in Track & Field and three in Weightlifting; and

WHEREAS, Justice Lee is recognized as the most decorated athlete in the history of Marathon High School, a distinction that reflects her extraordinary accomplishments and lasting impact on the school's athletic program; and

WHEREAS, during her sophomore year, Justice Lee earned two State Championships in Weightlifting and placed fourth in Shot Put at the State Track & Field Championships; and

WHEREAS, during her junior year, Justice Lee earned a State Championship in Weightlifting, was named State Runner-Up individually, contributed to her team's State Runner-Up finish, and achieved second place in Shot Put, third place in Discus, and eighth place in Javelin at the State Track & Field Championships; and

WHEREAS, during her senior year, Justice Lee earned two State Runner-Up titles in Weightlifting and captured a State Championship in Shot Put while also placing third in Discus at the State Track & Field Championships; and

WHEREAS, Justice Lee's accomplishments reflect not only athletic excellence, but also leadership, determination, sportsmanship, and a commitment to representing her school and community with pride and distinction; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA hereby recognizes and honors Justice Lee for her extraordinary athletic achievements and congratulates her on her remarkable success in Track & Field and Weightlifting.
