### **Parks and Recreation Report**

#### **PROGRAMS**

- Open Pickleball play continues M-F 8am-1pm-About 20 people per day are playing
- M-W-F Fitness Class is ongoing from 8:30-9:30 in the morning
- Bocce Ball on Tuesday and Thursday with about 20 people playing each time
- Weekly Parks Program at Kreative Kids Day Care on Wednesdays
- Weekly Wednesday Community Gardens Program and Plant Give-A-Way
- Adult Volleyball and Adult Basketball at the High School
- Home School PE ended for the school year
- Summer Camp Registration opened

#### **EVENTS**

- We hosted 3 field days for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders from Stanley Switlik at Community Park
- Leadership Monroe Spring Fest was held at Ocean Front on May 2
- We hosted a FAB GIRL WALK at Sombrero Beach on May 9<sup>th</sup>
- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation took place at the Tiki on May 28<sup>th</sup>
- Middle school students had a beach day at Sombrero Beach on May 22
- The Seniors from MHS had a Beach Luau at Sombrero Beach on May 20
- Registration for Summer Camp is almost 100%

## **REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS**

- Skate Park construction is ongoing
- Resodding of the Soccer Field was completed
- Ocean Front Dog park is having some improvements made
- Plans for demoing the Fire Tower are ongoing due to safety concerns in the structure-so we have barricaded the tower and pavilion for safety.
- 2 leaks were fixed at Community Park near the baseball fields.
- 2 Picnic Tables were replaced at Sombrero
- A bike rack was installed at Sunset Park in Grassy Key
- A NO BIKES OR SCOOTERS sign was placed on the DOCK at Sunset Park in Grassy Key
- Horseshoe Pits were installed at Community Park
- Flag Poles were installed behind center fields at the baseball fields to be able to fly the American Flag for the baseball and softball games
