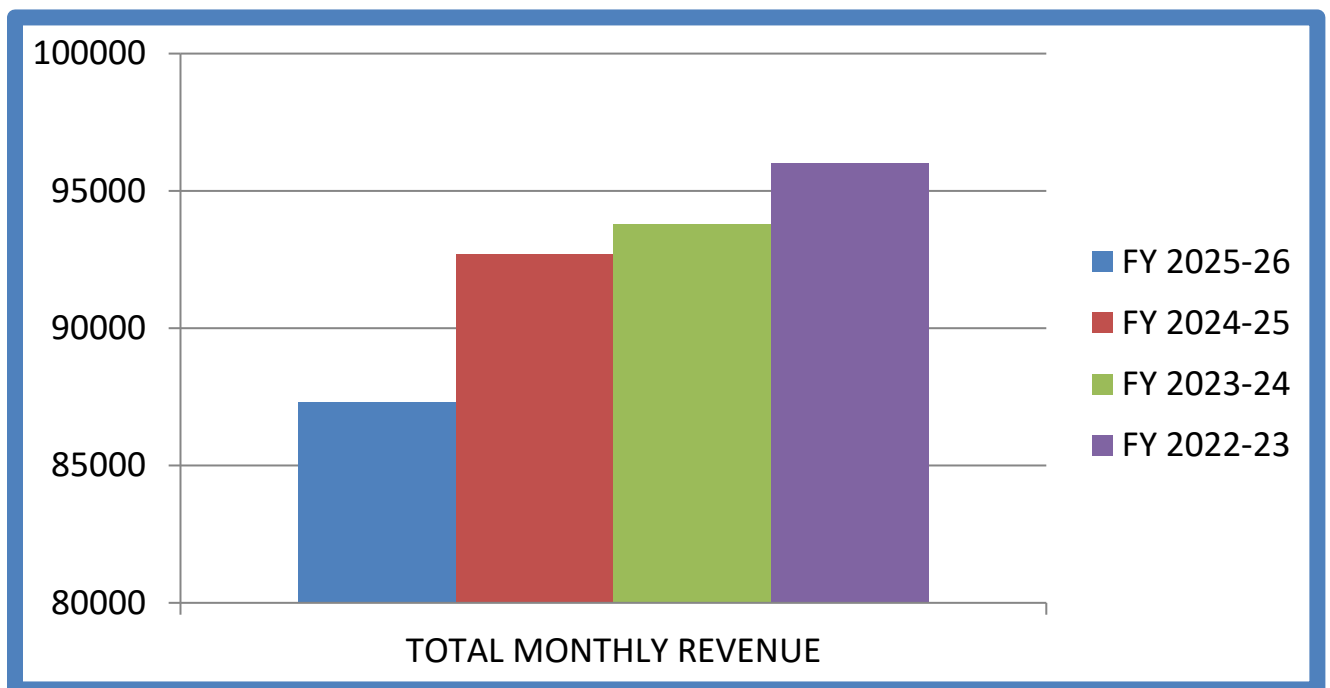

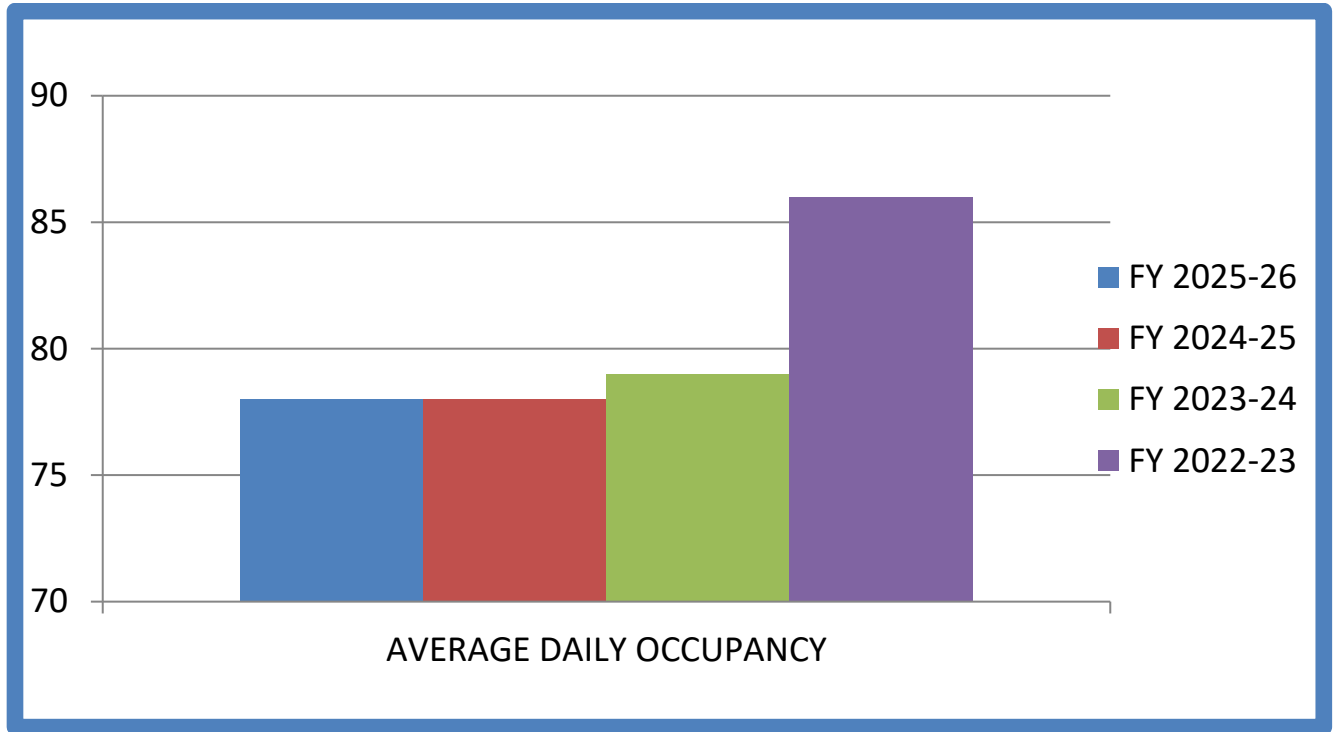
Re: May Monthly Report

News: The first of the bi-annual cleaning and inspection of our moorings by Cscape Const. was completed. Normal repairs were made for wear and tears.

The bay doors in our main building got treated for rust corrosion and repainted with industrial grade paint.

Our generator experienced a low battery voltage alert. Islamorada Power replaced the batteries and charger and got it back in working order.

The bath house and laundry machines had its normal repairs for wear and tear due to constant continuous use.

Projects: Coming into off season, the staff will be focusing on marina improvements and summer projects such as fire treat tiki huts, painting the bath house interior, replacing the water fountain, revamping our marina mural as well as improving the landscaping by buying and inserting more bushes/flowers.
