**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARATHON, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE CITY OF MARATHON SAFE STREETS FOR ALL
PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon is committed to improving roadway safety for all users, including motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, transit riders; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation established the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program to support local initiatives aimed at preventing roadway deaths and serious injuries through comprehensive safety planning and implementation; and

WHEREAS, the development and adoption of a Safe Streets for All Plan demonstrates the City's commitment to a data-driven, proactive approach to transportation safety consistent with the principles of the Federal "Vision Zero" initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets for All Plan evaluates existing roadway conditions, crash data, multimodal transportation needs, and areas of heightened safety concern throughout the City of Marathon; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets for All Plan identifies strategies, policies, infrastructure improvements, and implementation measures intended to reduce traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries for all roadway users; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon received grant funding assistance to support the preparation of the Safe Streets for All Plan, including public outreach, data collection, safety analysis, and project prioritization efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets for All Plan was developed through coordination with stakeholders, public agencies, community members, and transportation professionals to ensure a comprehensive and equitable approach to roadway safety; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Safe Streets for All Plan will position the City of Marathon to pursue future state and federal transportation safety funding opportunities and implement priority safety improvements identified within the Plan; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Safe Streets for All Plan will further the City's goals of

enhancing public safety, promoting multimodal transportation, and improving the overall quality of life for residents and visitors of the City of Marathon; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City of Marathon Safe Streets For All Plan is hereby adopted.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
