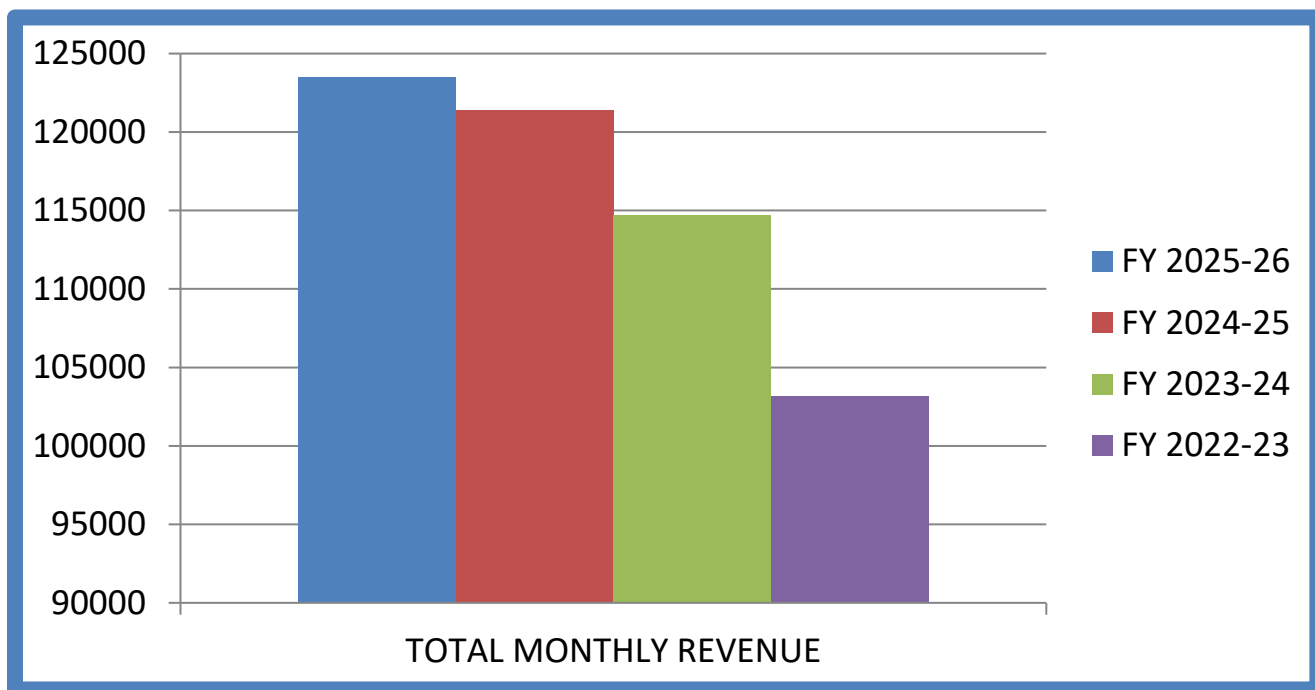

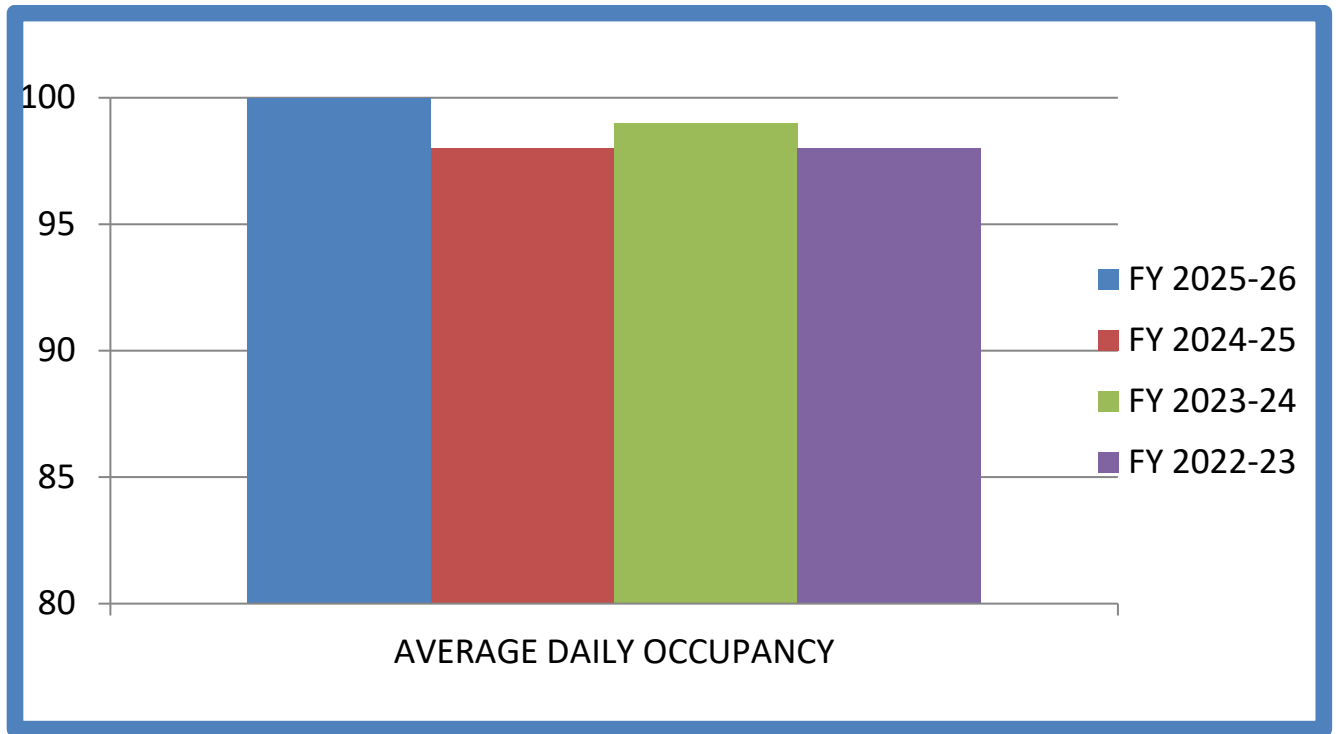
Re: March Monthly Report

The bath house and laundry machines had its normal repairs for wear and tear due to constant continuous use. One of our water heater needs replacing and we have contracted 3rd Generation Plumbing to do the work. The ice machine is finally running and dispensing ice on its own.
