BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION:

Grant agreement LPA0273 provided for \$2,433,051 of reimbursement funding towards the Sombrero Road Stormwater Injection Well Project. However, the City received funding for this project from Resilient Florida. Stewardship funding and Resilient Florida funding cannot be utilized on the same project since they are both State sources of funds, with Resilient Florida requiring a funding match. Therefore, the City is requesting to close LPA0723 and reallocate those funds toward LPA0724 for the Deep Well, Transmission Piping & Pumping Station project.
