## OPERATIONS:

- **Training:**
  - **Fire Officer Training:** All Fire Officers maintain daily Incident Management continuing education as well as this month's "Training Module June 2022".
  - **EMS Training:** This month the firefighters completed **726.08** hours of total training. This training included a 16-hour PALS course through a grant funded program, Area Familiarization at Bonefish Towers, and functional training with our new recruits for their required task book completion.
  - **Fire Training:** All firefighters continue to conduct daily shift drills; as well as completed this month's 4-hour module on NFPA 1584 FF Rehab and Medical Monitoring.
  - **ARFF:** This month the department conducted the annual ARFF Drill and completed 4-hours of training.
  - **Tactical Medic Program:** This month 2 fire fighters participated in 16 hours of SWAT Call Out and firearms qualifications with MCSO.
  - **Combined Training:** Target Solution software for all shifts, a total of 596 courses were taken which totaled 726.08 hours of training.
  - **Instructors on Staff:** We have a total of six instructors with live fire certifications and seven EMS instructors.

## BENEVOLENT FIREFIGHTER SERVICES

**Benevolent recruitment** – The Department continues to support recruitment of additional personnel coordinated through the Marathon Fire Rescue Benevolent Association.

## **INFORMATION –**

The department has hired 3 new firefighters. They have completed their training and have started their probation. They will be rotated between the 3 shifts so each officer can provide additional training and evaluate each employee.

The Marathon High School/School Board Fire Recruit Program has been completed. The department has hired two students from last year's program, and they are working on our inter-facility truck. The department will be hosting their paramedic school in August 2023 at the station.

Please make sure you are prepared for the upcoming storm season. Have your emergency plans updated and in place. The satellite system is being housed at city hall if needed for any loss of communication to the mainland. Please have your home prepared and a plan in case we need to evacuate.

The department participates in the Monroe County Emergency Management Drill in preparation for Storm season.

The weather has been extremely hot so far this year please make sure everyone stays hydrated and safe for the summer months.
