FCAA issues Precautionary Boil Water Notice after line break

MARATHON, FL (June 30, 2026) – The Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority has issued a Precautionary Boil Water Notice on Tuesday, June 30, following a transmission main break at Conch Key.

FCAA crews have located the break, and officials say repairs will take 12-15 hours.

The notice has been issued for all residents and businesses located in areas that experienced a drop in water pressure below 20 psi.

Those areas include:

- From Fiesta Key (Mile Marker 70) to Curry Hammock State Park (MM 56);
- From Knights Key (MM 47) to Beach Drive, Big Pine Key (MM 32);
- Torch keys;
- Ramrod Key;
- Summerland Key;
- Cudjoe Key;
- Upper Sugarloaf Key;

- Lower Sugarloaf Key;
- Baypoint;
- Bluewater;
- Shark Key;
- Rockland Key; and
- Boca Chica Key.

The notice is in effect through 3 p.m. Friday, July 3, or until FCAA cancels the precautionary notice.
