Learn real-life lifesaving skills with Marathon Fire Rescue's new CPR classes.

Register now for Marathon Fire Rescue CPR class set for Saturday, Aug. 29

MARATHON, FL (Aug. 27, 2026) – Marathon Fire Rescue will hold its second citizen CPR class on Saturday, Aug 29.

The four-hour session will be held at Station #14, 8900 Overseas Highway, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Another class is scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 19, and additional classes will be scheduled as instructors are available.



The instructor-led, hands-on session follows the American Heart Association's proven Heartsaver model, providing video-based instruction plus expert guidance to reinforce critical life-saving skills.

The Basic Life Support (BLS) course trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate breaths and ventilations, and provide early use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

Participants will earn AHA CPR (Adult, Child, and Infant) and First Aid certification upon completion, which is valid for two years.

Cost of the course is \$95.

Registration is required; visit <https://www.marathonfirerescue.org/cpr-classes> or use the QR code provided.

This course is accepted by the U.S. Coast Guard for captain's licenses and meets general certification requirements for general contractors and healthcare providers.

Private classes for groups of five or more also can be scheduled with dates and times negotiable.
