City offices to close for July 4th holiday weekend

MARATHON, FL (June 29, 2026) – City of Marathon offices will be closed beginning at noon on Thursday, July 2, in observance of the Fourth of July holiday weekend.

City offices will reopen on Monday, July 6, at 8 a.m.

Earlier this month, Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis announced state offices would be closed for five days, from Thursday, July 2, through Monday, July 6, including the state-recognized observation of the holiday on Friday, July 3. State offices will reopen on Tuesday, July 7.

This year marks America's 250th anniversary of its independence.
