City Council faces light agenda for Aug. 11 meeting

MARATHON, FL (Aug. 6, 2026) – The Marathon City Council is set to meet on Tuesday, Aug. 11, at 5:30 p.m., with a relatively light agenda.

Council member Lynn Landry has sponsored a discussion on the search for a new city manager.



At a Special Call meeting on July 28, council agreed they wanted to reinterview two candidates – City Clerk Diane Clavier and St. Lucie County Deputy County Administrator Mayte Santamaria — and sought a third possible candidate, interim City Manager Steve Williams.

Both Clavier and Santamaria have since withdrawn from consideration.

Also on the agenda is an update on the city's Deep Injection Well Project, and Mayor Lynny Del Gaizo is scheduled to discuss Fair Insurance Rates for Monroe (FIRM).

The remainder of items are on the consent agenda, including distribution of grant funds for local non-profit organizations. Funding amounts were determined by the City Council following a workshop in June.
