City Council faces full agenda for Sept. 8 meeting

MARATHON, FL (Sept. 3, 2026) – The Marathon City Council is scheduled to meet Tuesday, Sept. 8, with a slate of ordinances for first and second public hearings and enactment, as well as multiple resolutions on the consent agenda.

The meeting will begin at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Marathon City Hall, 9805 Overseas Highway.



Among the items up for second public hearing and enactment are Ordinance 2026-23, which updates the city's towing ordinance to match state law, and Ordinances 2026-24, 2026-25, and 2026-26, which amend the city's Code of Ordinances and Land Development Regulations regarding chickees and tikis.

Among the resolutions set for adoption is Resolution 2026-78, approving a contract for City Attorney Steve Williams to take over as city manager. Williams has been serving as interim city manager since February.

Additionally, Resolution 2026-81 would approve a contract with General Asphalt Co. for the replacement of the 117th Street Bridge, and Resolutions 2026-84 and 2026-85 would allow the transfer 50 early evacuation workforce affordable housing allocations to Marathon from the cities of Key Colony Beach and Layton, respectively.

Two resolutions focus on visual improvements: Resolution 2026-82 would approve an agreement with Professional Engineering Services to design lighting for a multi-use trail along portions of Coco Plum Drive, while Resolution 2026-87 would approve a contract with VisualScape for landscaping along U.S. 1 in front of the Florida Keys Marathon International Airport. Both projects are grant-funded.
