Marathon Fire Rescue Station #14 will host a 9/11 Remembrance Ceremony at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, Sept. 11, the 25th anniversary of the terrorist attacks in New York and Washington, D.C. The station is located at 8900 Overseas Highway.

Marathon Fire Rescue to hold 9/11 Remembrance Ceremony

MARATHON, FL (Sept. 3, 2026) – Marathon Fire Rescue will mark the 25th anniversary of the Sept. 11, 2001, attacks on the World Trade Center buildings and the Pentagon with a 9/11 Remembrance Ceremony.

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The event will be held at Station #14, 8900 Overseas Highway, starting at 8:30 a.m., with the ordering of the U.S. flag to be flown at half-staff.

Following opening remarks from Fire Chief Shana Rogers and Assistant Fire Marshal Mike Card, the ceremony will include a variety of guest speakers, including interim City Manager and City Attorney Steve Williams, Mayor Lynny Del Gaizo, and Monroe County Emergency Management Director Cory Schwisow.

Additionally, Father Oscar Perez of San Pablo Catholic Church will lead attendees in prayer, and Marathon American Legion Post 154 will present colors and provide a 21-gun salute.

The post will perform “Taps” in honor of the fallen military members as the flag is raised to full staff.

Several members of the Marathon City Council are expected to attend, as well as numerous city employees and local dignitaries.

The National Day of Service and Remembrance is observed on Sept. 11 in honor of the memory of the nearly 3,000 people who lost their lives in the terrorist attacks in New York and Washington.

A fourth attack, which targeted the U.S. Capitol and the White House, was thwarted by passengers aboard Flight 93.

Ceremonies marking the anniversary will be held throughout Monroe County and across the nation.
