

# Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Public Meeting June 9

The City of Marathon was awarded a grant from the Department of Transportation as part of the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) program. A comprehensive safety action plan (referred to as an “Action Plan”) is a plan to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries in the city. Action plans are the foundation of the SS4A grant program.

The [SS4A program](#) provides funding for two main types of grants: Planning and Demonstration Grants for Action Plans, including supplemental safety planning and/or safety demonstration activities, and Implementation Grants. The City of Marathon awarded the contract for the development of the Action Plan to Stantec through resolution.

## **7 Components of an Action Plan**

The goal of an Action Plan is to develop a holistic, well-defined strategy to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries in a locality, Tribal area, or region.

A successful Action Plan includes the following seven key components:

1. Leadership commitment and goal setting
2. Planning structure
3. Safety analysis
4. Engagement and collaboration
5. Policy and process changes
6. Strategy and project selections
7. Progress and transparency
