City to increase wastewater rates on Oct. 1

MARATHON, FL (July 30, 2026) – Effective Oct. 1, 2026, customers receiving wastewater service from the City of Marathon will see a 7% increase in the city sewer's base facility, customer and flow charges.



The increase was approved by Resolution 2024-65, which allowed for a 7% increase in fiscal years 2025-27 and a 1% increase in FY 2028.

Customers currently paying \$30.74 in base facility charges will pay \$32.89 starting in October. The customer charge will increase from \$19.23 to \$20.58, and the flow charge (per 1,000 gallons) will rise from \$10.89 to \$11.65.

The Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority provides third-party billing services for the city by including the city's sewer charges on applicable FCAA bills. Sewer rates are established by the City of Marathon and are separate from FCAA's water rates, which will increase 8.4% on Oct. 1.
