**Mosquito Control sets aerial adulticide mission for Thursday, July 2**

**MARATHON, FL (July 1 2026)** – The Florida Keys Mosquito Control District has scheduled an aerial adulticide mission Thursday, July 2, from 6 to 8:30 a.m., over Fat Deer Key, Coco Plum, Grassy Key, and Duck Key.

The helicopter mission will be completed, weather permitting, using naled, which is part of the district's integrated pest management program to control migrating adult mosquitoes.

It is a non-persistent insecticide that breaks down rapidly when applied in the manner employed by the district.
