Safe Streets for All public meeting set for July 14

MARATHON, FL (June 12, 2026) – The City of Marathon was awarded a grant from the Department of Transportation as part of the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) program. A comprehensive safety action plan (referred to as an “Action Plan”) is a plan to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries in the city. Action plans are the foundation of the SS4A grant program.

A public meeting will be held Tuesday, July 14, 2026, at City Hall to review the recommended safety improvements for the Top 5 crash intersections in the city, as well as the recommended city-wide safety and policy improvements for vehicle, bicycle, e-bike and pedestrian travel.

The SS4A program provides funding for two main types of grants: Planning and Demonstration Grants for Action Plans, including supplemental safety planning and/or safety demonstration activities, and Implementation Grants. The City of Marathon awarded the contract for the development of the Action Plan to Stantec through resolution.
