**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARATHON, FLORIDA, AWARDING ONE AFFORDABLE ROGO
ALLOCATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
PROTECTION, DIVISION OF RECREATION AND PARKS**

WHEREAS, within the city limits of the City of Marathon Florida (the "City") the existing supply of affordable/workforce housing is insufficient to meet the current demand for affordable/workforce housing;

WHEREAS, the City has a pool of existing affordable ROGO allocations for distribution as determined by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council at its May 9, 2006 meeting voted unanimously to award one affordable allocation to the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks for the construction of one affordable single family dwelling unit at Curry Hammock State Park.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby awards one affordable ROGO allocation to the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks for the construction of one affordable single family dwelling unit at Curry Hammock State Park

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
