RESOLUTION NO. 2014-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING ANNUAL PROCEDURES FOR DEVELOPING LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES AT THE STATE AND FEDERAL LEVELS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon has interests in the legislative agendas at both the State and Federal levels; and

WHEREAS, agreements with professional consulting and lobbying firms are in place at both levels; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set up a general annual procedure with such firms to make best use of their services, enhance communication and allow the City to maximize the effectiveness of the City's lobbying efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the City Council to adopt a legislative program to present to its representatives at the State and Federal levels of government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. The Marathon City Council, City Manager and staff will follow the following annual guidelines at the State level:

June - initial discussion of next year's priorities

July through September – lobbyist to meet at least once with the City Council and staff to assist in developing legislative priorities

October - revising and passing of legislative priorities

January-February - delegation visit to Tallahassee

March - participation in Florida Keys Days

May - lobbyist to provide written and verbal report on legislative session

Section 3. The Marathon City Council, City Manager and staff will follow the following annual guidelines at the Federal level:

January - initial discussion of year's priorities

January through February - lobbyist to meet at least once with the City Council and staff to assist in developing legislative priorities

February - revising and passing of legislative priorities

March - delegation visit to Washington, D.C.

Following January/February - lobbyist to provide written and verbal report on legislative session

Section 4. Other trips may be needed on a case by case basis

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
