

**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2022-77**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA PURSUANT TO SECTION 32-31 IDENTIFYING THE STREET CORTE CHICA AS AN ADDITIONAL NO PARKING AREA SUBJECT TO TICKETING UNDER THE SECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 32-31 of the City's Code of Ordinances provides that the City Council may restrict or prohibit parking within identified areas of the city rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, there have been recent complaints from neighbors on Sombrero Beach Road about overflow parking from owners of vehicles utilizing Sombrero Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved "No Parking" areas subject to ticketing only pursuant to Resolution 2022-44; and

WHEREAS, inadvertently, the street Corte Chica was not included in the list of streets perpendicular to the southerly terminal end of Sombrero Beach Road subject to ticketing and by this Resolution is hereby added; and

WHEREAS, the "No Parking" area shall be identified by appropriate signage,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.


Section 2. A "No Parking" area is hereby designated for Corte Chica. Appropriate signage shall be posted identifying the area. Said area is subject to ticketing pursuant to this Section for the street identified, enforcement to be undertaken at the direction of the Sheriff's Office, the City Code Compliance Department, the City Manager, or his/her designee, and particularly at the request of local residents of the five streets perpendicular to Sombrero Beach Road adjacent to the beach.

Section 3. The City Council may relax entirely this restriction by their specific direction provided at a Council meeting for requested events and holidays. The 4th of July holiday shall be one of the "No Parking" exceptions.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption. The No Parking restriction shall go into effect as designated parking areas are defined and signage is installed.
