Except as herein or heretofore expressly modified, all terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and shall cover the performance of, and payment for, any work authorized hereunder. Any defined terms not defined in this Change Order shall have the meanings set forth in the Agreement.

The Change Order is a result of: The proposed changes involve supply and installation of carrier conduits for the chemical piping as well as replacement of piping with a PEX system, inclusive of all necessary fittings and hardware. This transition to a carrier system with PEX is anticipated to enhance both the serviceability, lifespan of the system and reduce the potential for leaks in the future. Additionally, staff has requested the installation of priming ports to aid in the priming process in the event of an outage at the chemical skids. As a result of these modifications, additional time will be allocated to accommodate the procurement of materials and labor.
