RESOLUTION 2025-91**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA,  
ADOPTING THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026;  
AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY  
THE BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 16, 2025, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (the "FY 2025-2026"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 23, 2025, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate, and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2025-2026, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the tentative operating budget for FY 2025-2026 in the amount of \$144,676,201.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1.** The FY 2025-2026 final operating budget is adopted.

**Section 2.** Funds appropriated in the FY 2025-2026 budget may be expended by and with the approval of the City Manager in accordance with the City Charter, State law, and the ordinances, resolutions and policies and procedures of the City. Supplemental appropriations or the reduction of appropriations, if any, shall be made in accordance with the City Charter.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
