

RESOLUTION NO. 00-06-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT AUTHORITY'S (THE "FKAA") IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MARATHON WASTEWATER MASTER PLAN, INCLUDING THE LITTLE VENICE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the "City") was created by Chapter 99-427, Laws of Florida, which approved the incorporation of the City effective November 30, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the City is located within the Florida Keys Area of Critical State Concern (the "FKACSC"), and is therefore required to coordinate the implementation of its Comprehensive Plan, programs and regulatory activities consistent with the principals for guiding development within the FKACSC; and

WHEREAS, one of the principals for guiding development within the FKACSC is that the City must protect the value, efficiency, cost effectiveness and amortized life of existing and proposed sewage collection and disposal facilities within its boundaries.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Support of the FKAA. In accordance with the principals for guiding development in the FKACSC, and the objectives, goals and policies of the City Comprehensive Plan, the City supports the FKAA's implementation of the Marathon Wastewater Master Plan including, but not limited to, the Little Venice Wastewater Treatment Project.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
