

**RESOLUTION NO. 00-07-29**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS; AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE APPLICATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, there are grant opportunities that arise from time to time that require an applicant's governing body to specifically approve the grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, the time requirements for some grant applications may not provide sufficient time for formal submittal of the application to the City Council for approval prior to submission to the granting agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the importance and value to the residents of the City to participate in the State, Federal and County grants that may be available to supplement the City's financial resources.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1.     Recitals.     The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2.     Authorization.     The City Manager is authorized to prepare and submit grant applications on behalf of the City. The appropriate city officials, Mayor, Vice Mayor or City Manager, as specified in the particular grant application, are authorized to execute the applications subject to review and approval of the application by the City Attorney. In the


event that a particular grant program requires a commitment to provide matching funds, the above referenced officials are authorized to submit said applications on behalf of the City.

Section 3.    Effective Date.    This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


