## BOOT KEY HARBOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE "MISSION STATEMENT"

The Boot Key Harbor Advisory Committee shall adhere to the following Mission Statement:

The Advisory Committee shall provide specific recommendations for funding sources for the clean-up of the Boot Key Harbor Environment, to review and evaluate the Boot Key Harbor Management Plan and make appropriate recommendations to the City Council, consider the acquisition of Boot Key by the State of Florida, develop conceptual recreational uses for Boot Key, provide recommendations as to the usage of contiguous parcels and corresponding bay bottom, provide recommendations for the proposed County-State bay-bottom swap, and prepare a ten (10) to twenty (20) year Master Plan for the development of Boot Key Harbor which shall include the anticipated "opening" of Cuba and a future redevelopment plan for residential purposes.
