RESOLUTION NO. 00- 09-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING A FINE STRUCTURE FOR CODE VIOLATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2000, the City of Marathon, Florida enacted Ordinance No. 00-07-05 (the "Ordinance"), authorizing the establishment of a Code Compliance System; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance, the City Council may establish a schedule of fines for violations of the City Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Fine Structure. The City adopts the following fine structure for a reduced civil penalty, a finding of violation of the cited offense or a mandatory penalty for any third offense or more. Fines shall accrue daily for each violation until the violation is brought into compliance:

Section 3. Non-exclusive Remedy. Nothing contained in this Resolution shall prohibit the City from enforcing its Code by any other means including, but not limited to a summons, a notice to appear in the County Court, an arrest, a civil action for injunctive relief, a stop work order, or demolition.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
